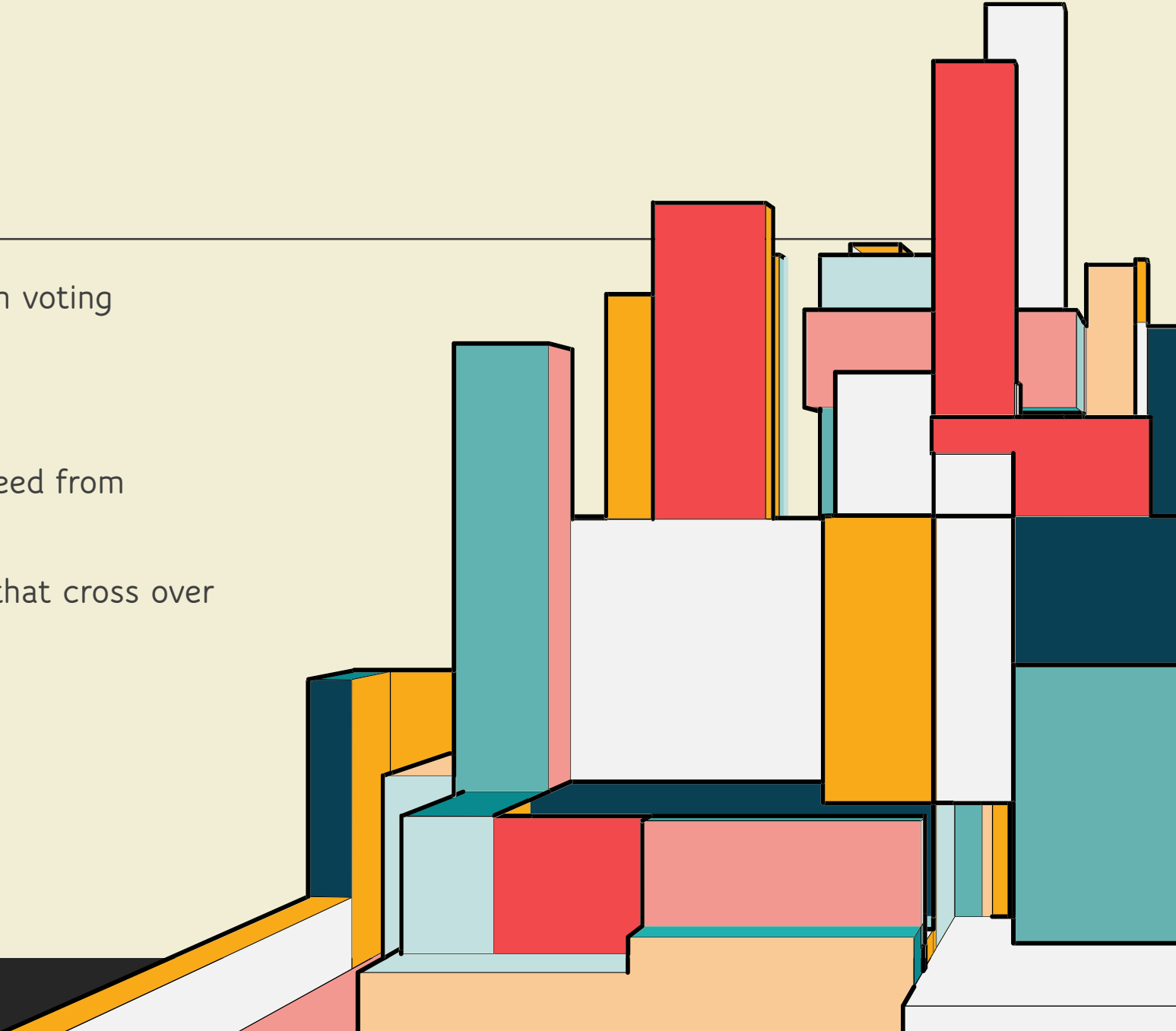

Question 1: Do you program your own voting machines at the county level?

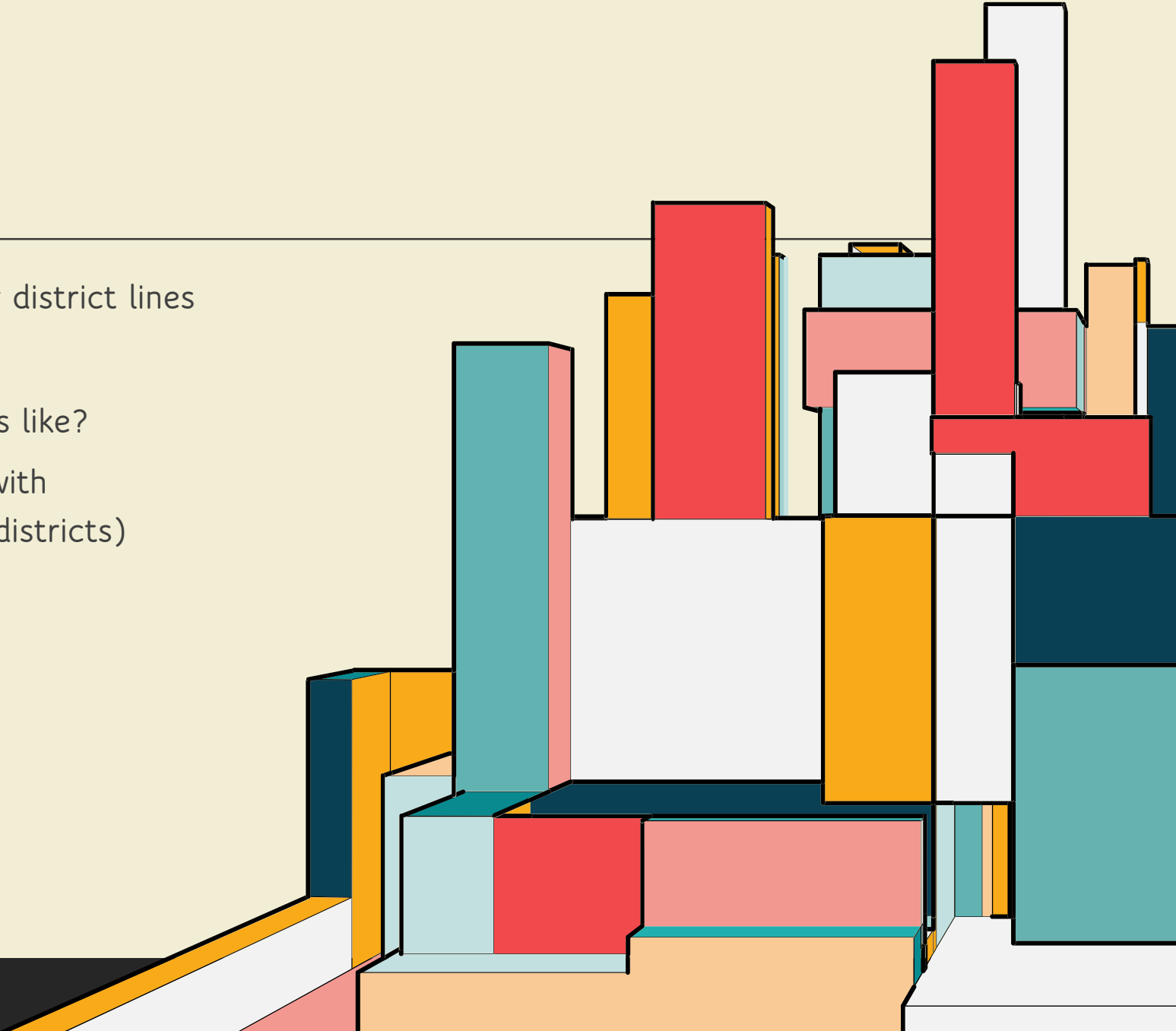
- What's that process like?

Question 2: How do you keep all your district lines and ballot styles straight?

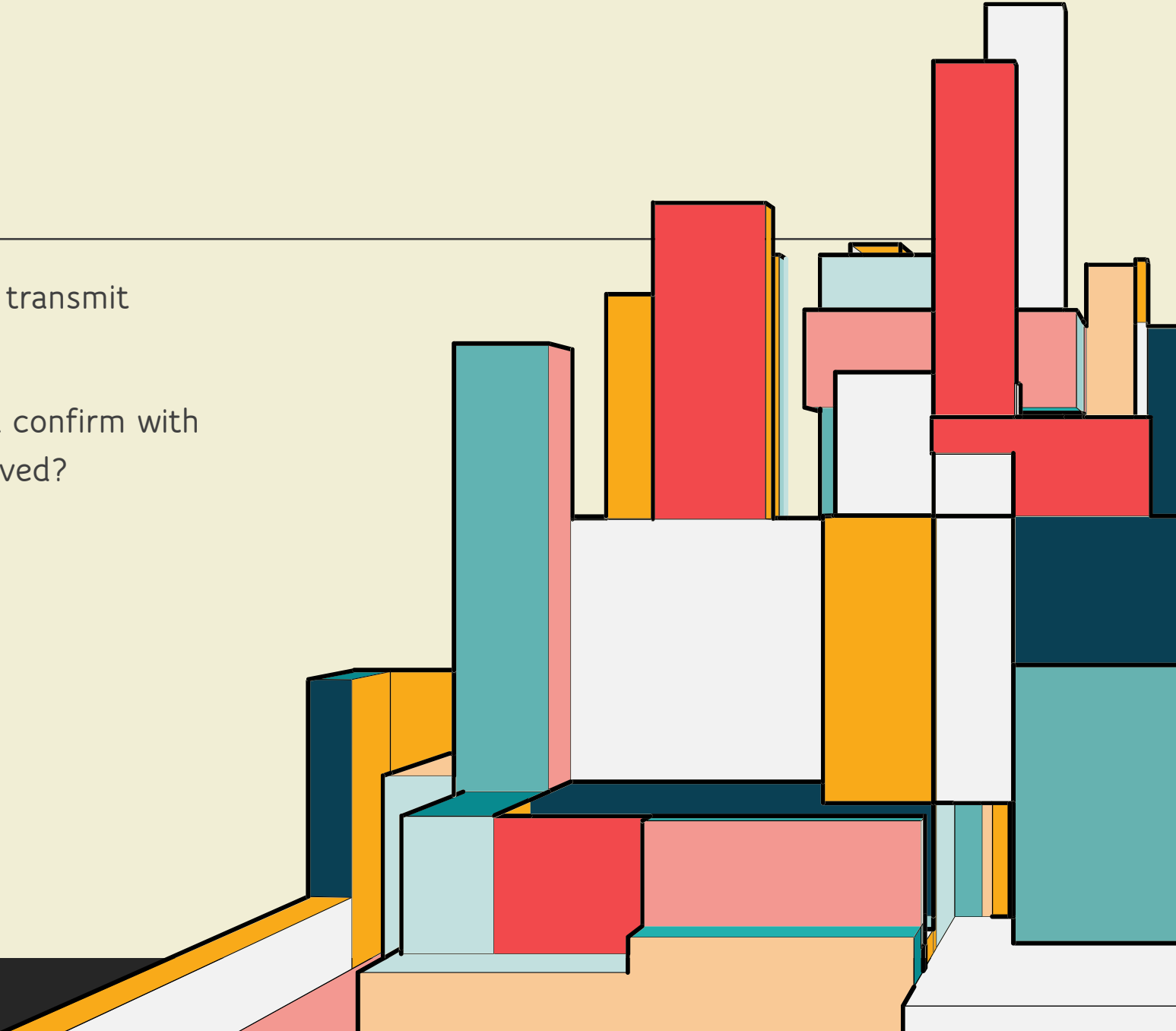
- What's the proofing process like?

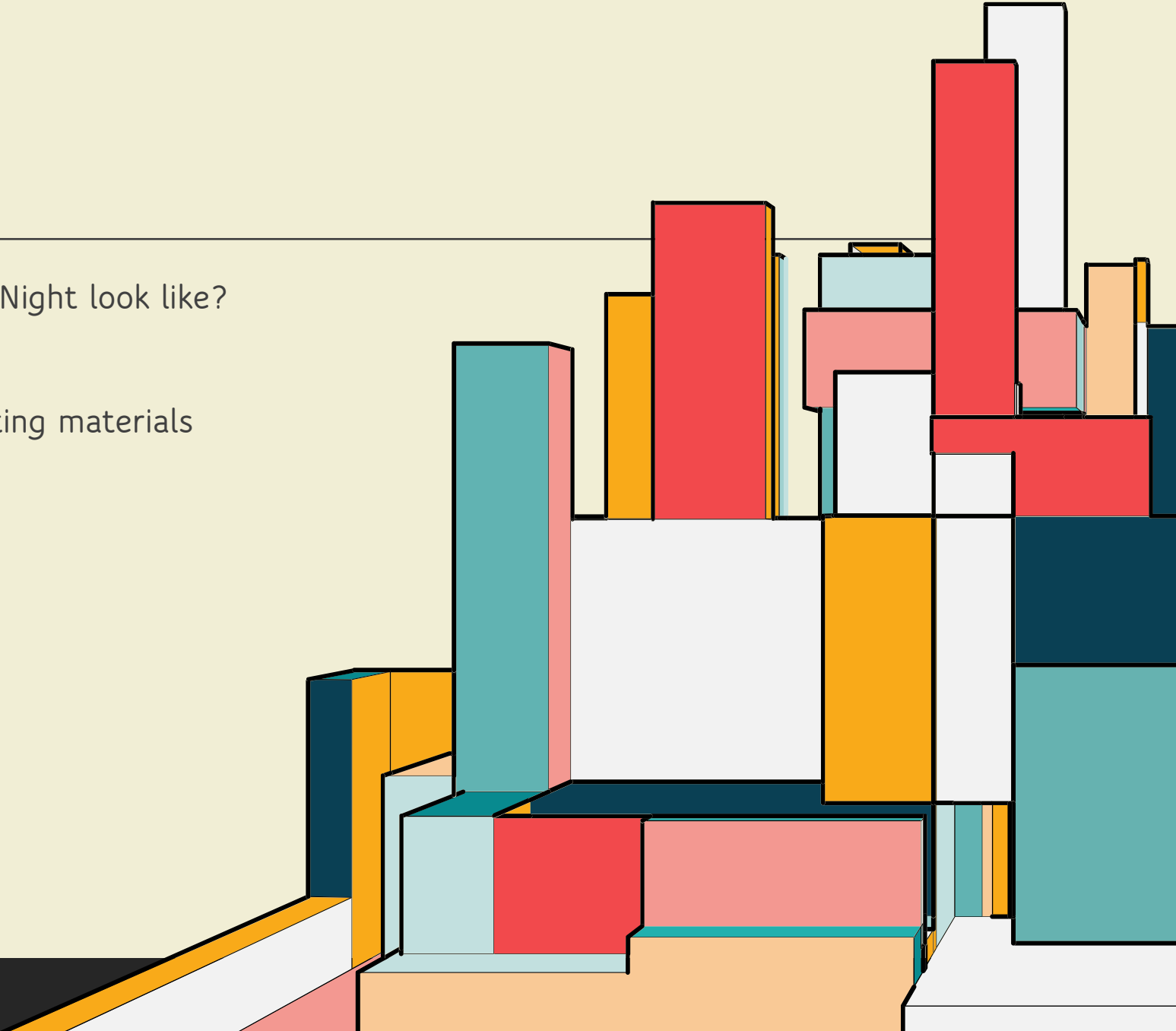

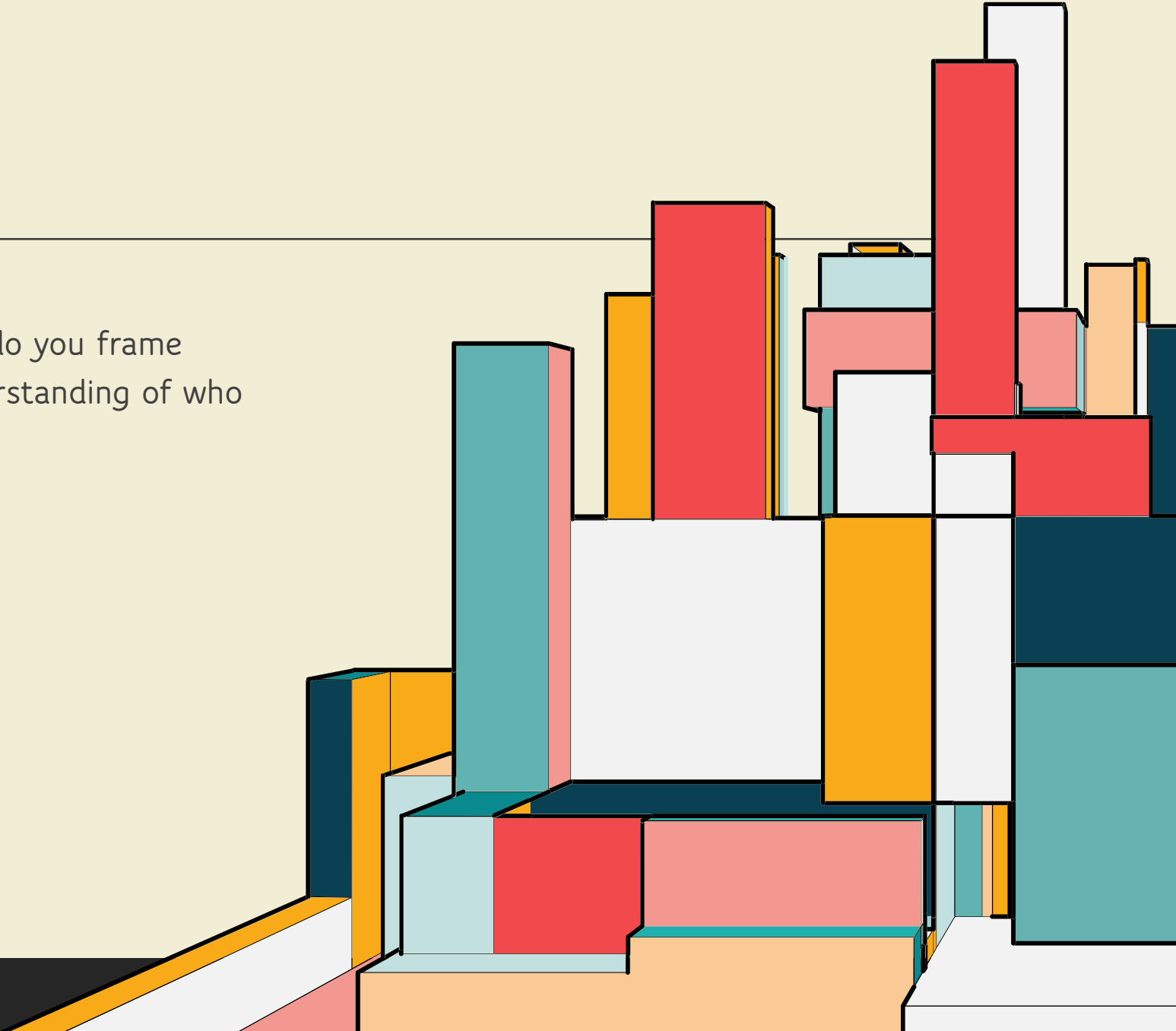
