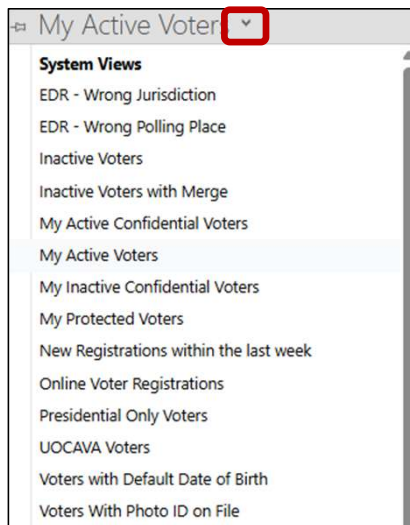

System Views in WisVote

What is a System View?



A pre-programmed filter for associated data

Created by WEC developers & staff

Available for all associated views in WisVote

Access w/ down chevron next to view name



System Views in WisVote

Sorting vs Filtering



Sorting

- Reorders data based on column used
- No data is removed from view
- Can only sort by 1 column at a time

Filtering

- Shows only data that matches selected filters
- Can filter multiple columns at a time
- Filtered results can be sorted

All columns can be sorted, not all views can be filtered

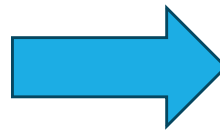

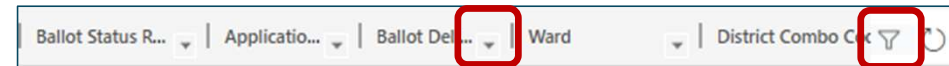
Sorting vs Filtering

Filtering

Column filtering must be “turned on”



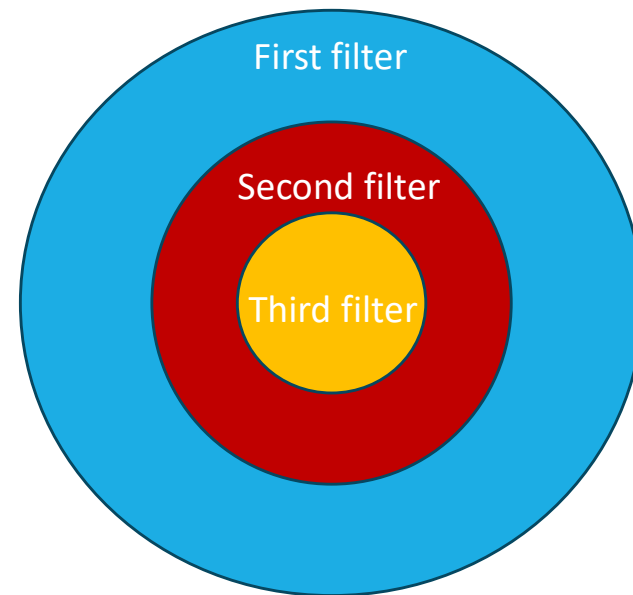
When activated, filter icon turns white
down chevrons appear in all columns

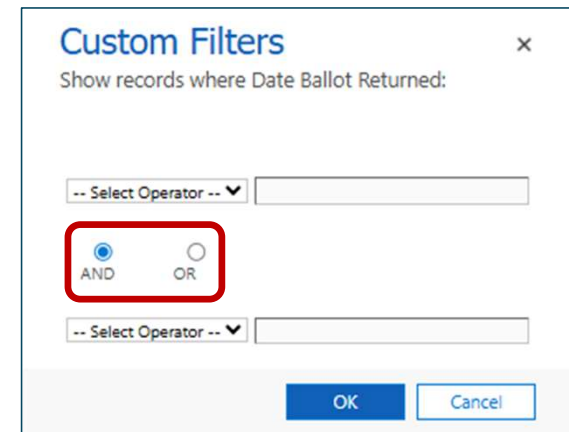
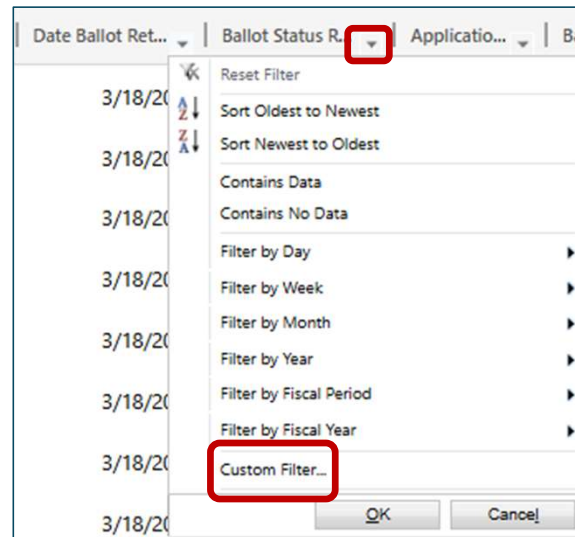

Filtering

Clicking a down chevron will show filter options

Options are not all the same, determined by data type in the selected column

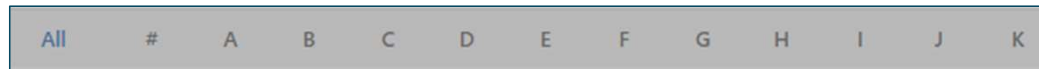
Custom Filter option available for all columns

Filtering



All views w/ a name field can use letter filtering option

Located at the bottom of the WisVote System View

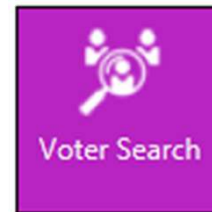
Available in most views, even if data cannot be sorted alphabetically

All filters can be cleared by reloading the view (F5), clicking the filter icon again, or selecting “Reset Filter”

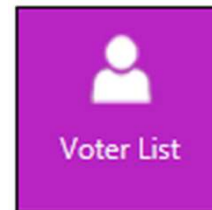

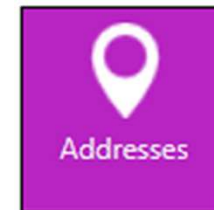
Voter search tile – multiple voters, flexible search



Voter List tile – single or small group, limited search

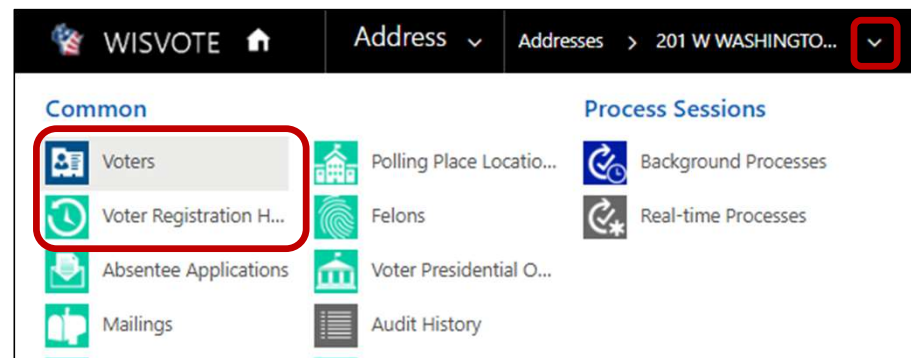


Address tile – all records tied to an address

Address Tile



All address records have a Voter & Voter Reg History views

Voters view – All voter records currently assigned to the address

Voter Registration History view – All registration history records associated with the address record



Address Tile

Locate records w/ typos in name or DOB

Includes records excluded by Voter Search tile

Reg History view shows voters now registered elsewhere


Voter List Tile

Best practice – search using first & last name

Active & Inactive records can be searched

Quickest option for single voter searches

All records containing terms will be searched


Count Only – runs search, only returns number of records

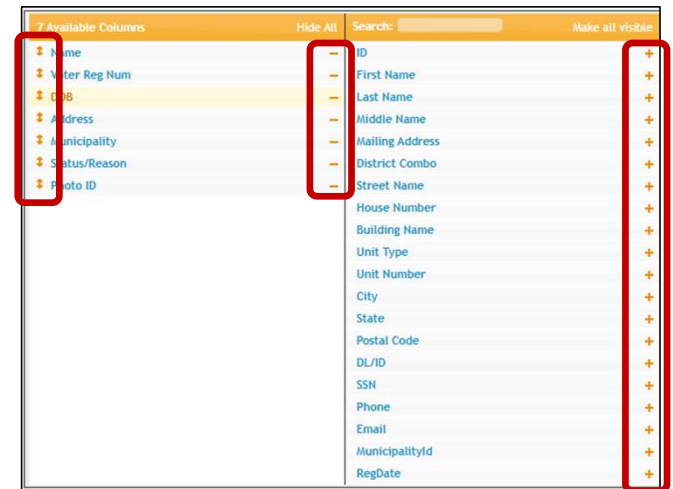
Column options can be customized and reordered

Arrows change order of columns

Plus/minus signs add/remove columns from results view

Columns reset after leaving Voter Search tile



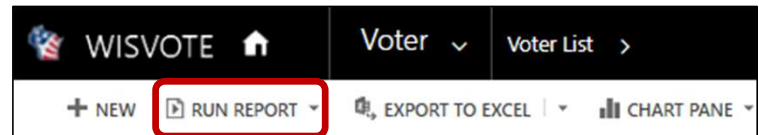

Warnings!

Check report results against documents!

False positives – Name changes & post-election registrations/merges

More false positives further away from Election Day

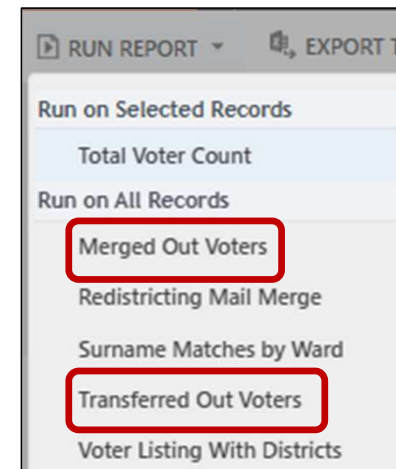
WisVote Reports

Merged/Transferred Out Reports

No notification for merges or voters registering elsewhere!

Merged Out Report – All voter records merged into another, outside your jurisdiction between provided dates

Transferred Out Report – All voter records directly updated record outside your jurisdiction between the provided dates



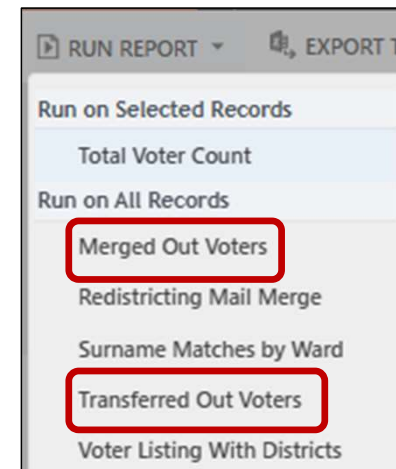
WisVote Reports

Merged/Transferred Out Reports

Help clean up physical voter files (4-years after deactivation)

Should run on a regular basis to keep size manageable

Also useful for finding bad merges and updates!

WARNINGS!

Great power, Great Responsibility, etc. etc.

Always include a jurisdiction filter!

Confidential and Protected voters not excluded by default!!

Advanced find will search all records in WV if you let it

Can impact WV performance for all users!

Use advanced find when needed – not for curiosity

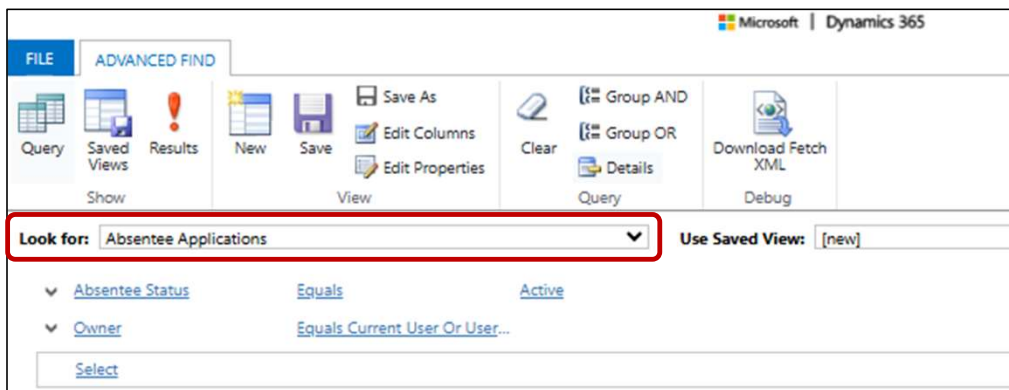



Editing an existing view

Review the system view filters to determine next steps

Owner filter – limits to user jurisdiction, can be used instead of Jurisdiction

These filters prevent confidential and protected voter from appearing in results




Now to add/remove columns from the report

To remove, highlight a column and click **Remove**

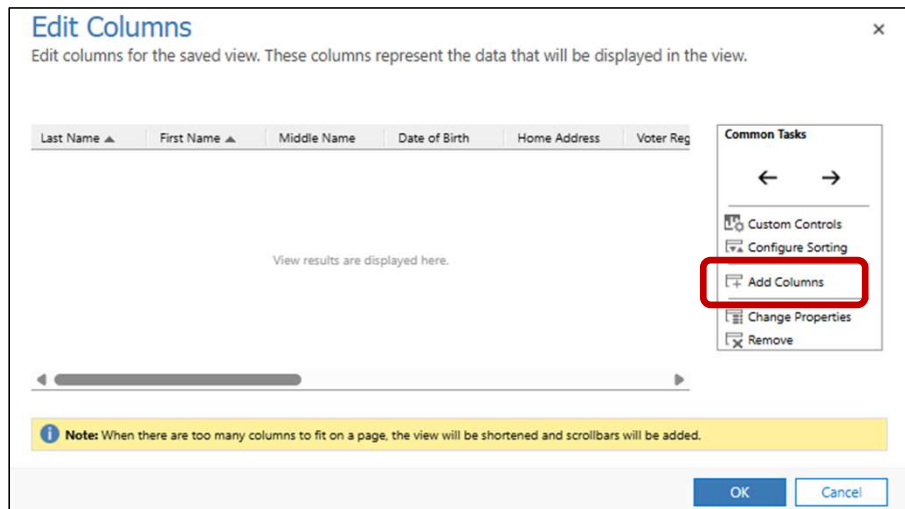

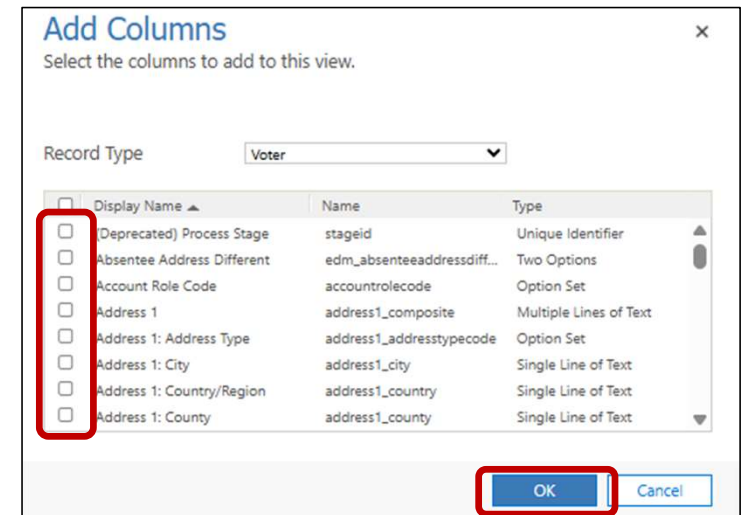

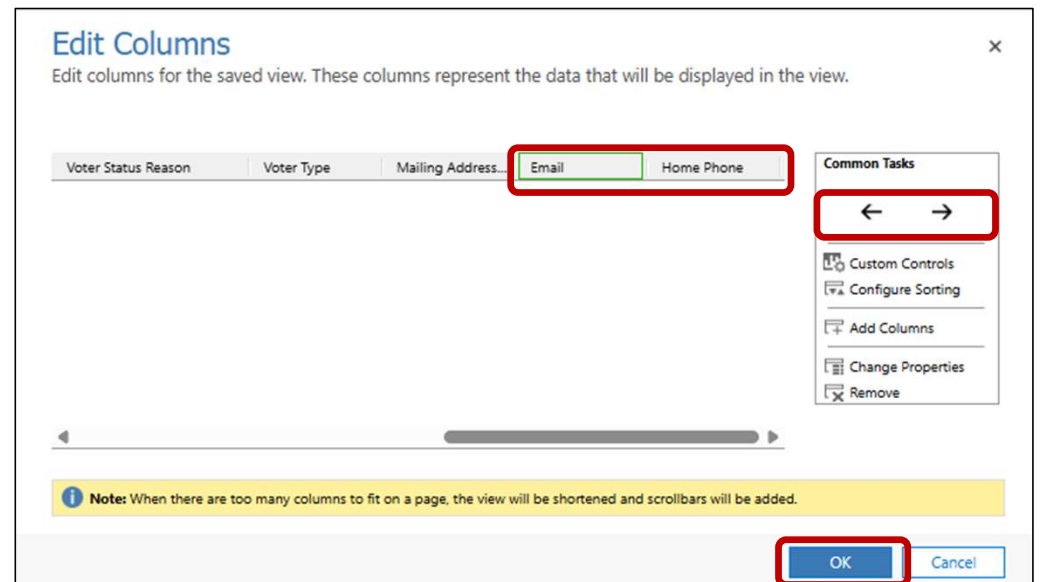

When done, click **Okay**

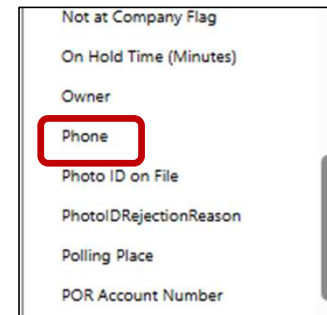
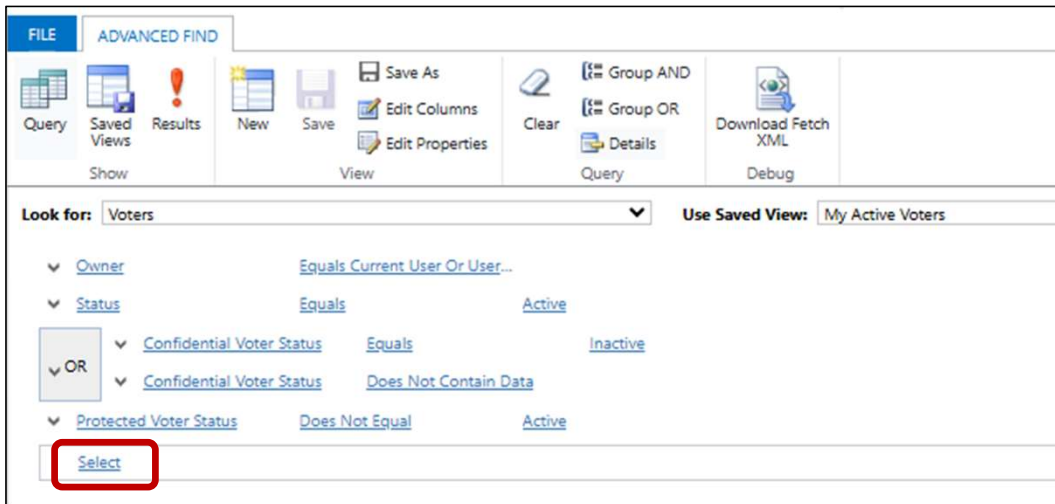


